- 1) What was the situation in the Northern Kingdom?
- 2) Hezekiah put his faith in God's promise to Solomon in 2 Chronicles 7:14. Are there any of God's promises you place your faith in?
- 3) Read Romans 11:2-5. What is a remnant?
- 4) Read Acts 17:27. How does this apply to the Israelites in the Northern Kingdom?

Going Deeper

- 5) Read Hosea 6:6. How does Hezekiah's prayer relate to this? How might we apply this in our church? What is your attitude towards those people who are seeking God but don't know how to behave?
- 6) How should the truth that God isn't far from anyone motivate us in our Christian witness?
- 7) What are some of the hallmarks of renewal that we see in verses 21-27? Do you know of any revivals that have taken place in church history?
