## Discussion Questions

### The Essentials

- 1) Who are the women on their way to the tomb? What do we know about them?
- 2) Why was the stone rolled away?
- 3) How might we act as if Jesus was still dead in our day-to-day lives?
- 4) Imagine what would have happened if the women had simply believed in Jesus when He repeatedly told them that He would be killed but rise again after three days.
- 5) Why can it be so hard for us to simply trust in Jesus' words?

### Going Deeper

- 6) What are some good pieces of evidence for the historical case of Jesus' resurrection?
- 7) Is it an over-statement to say that the whole of the Christian faith rests on the angel's proclamation, 'He isn't here, He has risen', and the many, subsequent appearances of Jesus alive and well, being true? Why? Why not?
