The Essentials

- 1) Why might it be hard for us to rejoice when others rejoice and weep when they weep?
- 2) Read 1 Timothy 2:1. What does it mean to intercede for someone?
- 3) What are some of the challenges of living out Romans 12:16 within an international church? Why is humility so important here?
- 4) Who are your enemies? How might you do good to them?

Going Deeper

- 5) What is the link between identifying with someone and interceding for them?
- 6) How does Jesus embody these commands in Romans 12:15-21?
- 7) Which of these commands convicts you the most? What area of your life might God be putting His finger on, bringing about change, in order for you to live these commands out?
