- 4) What would you say to a Christian who is struggling to remember that they have been called out of the darkness?

- 5) What works of darkness might Christians expose? (Ephesians 5:11)
- 6) How can Christians make the most of every opportunity? What might hinder us from doing this? (Ephesians 5:16)
- 7) Why is the image of not being under the influence of alcohol, but instead under the influence of the Holy Spirit such an apt and powerful one?
